Situated on the shores of Lake Como at Barzano, the company was created to meet a need — for a receptacle that would be the equal, in terms of style and quality, of the luxurious watch it was designed to hold.

Most watch enthusiasts build up a collection of their favourite accoutrements, so having a set of matching cases in which to house them — and some Scatola del Tempo cases are multi-watch holders — is essential to maintain an aesthetic unity to the collection.

A case that offers solid protection while travelling is also crucial. It should be functional and do the job it is designed for, as well as reflecting the taste and personality of its owner, much as high-quality luggage does.

And then, most important of all, and the cornerstone of Scatola del Tempo's success, are those practical cases that are the company's exclusive brainchild — the ones that actually wind your watch for you while you're not wearing it.

Complicated watches with automatic-winding mechanical movements need care and attention, which owners are not always able to give, especially if they have several of them. Which is where the Scatola del Tempo case comes in.

Its series of mechanical cases, known as “Rotors”, has been designed to keep these precious watches wound, by means of a rotating mechanism inside each one that substitutes the natural movement of the wrist. These



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
